#### DO YOU KNOW?

A "pall" is the piece of stiff linen, or cardboard covered with linen, usually between four and seven inches square, that covers the chalice at Mass so as to prevent dust and other particles from landing in the chalice. Often, the pall is either simply adorned with a cross or may have a colorful depiction of Our Lord, Our Lady, or some Eucharistic design. The cloth that is spread over the coffin at funeral Masses, usually of the same color as the vestments used for the liturgy, is also called a pall.
