DO YOU KNOW?

The title of monsignor in the Roman Catholic Church signifies a priest who has distinguished himself and has been honored for his service to the church. The Bishop nominates a priest who he recognizes for his exceptional service to the Church. The Pope reviews the nominations and makes the final decision. Monsignor is an honorary title, rather than a specific position in the church hierarchy, so a monsignor does not necessarily have any duties distinct from those of any other priest. However, some positions within the Vatican automatically carry the title of monsignor.

Any person wishing to donate money for after funeral receptions should write checks to OLBS church and reference "Funeral Reception". Cash donations should go to the Bookkeeper.
