## DO YOU KNOW?

The Church requires that a crucifix be visible during the celebration of Mass to remind us of the sacrifice of Jesus on the altar of the cross, which is made present for us each time we celebrate the Holy Eucharist. A simple cross doesn’t have the same visual or spiritual impact. Of course, we know that Jesus has risen from the dead but the crucifix reminds us of the suffering he endured before the resurrection could take place. Spiritually speaking, the crucifix can help us better accept and live the words of Christ to “deny yourselves, take up your cross daily, and follow Me”. When some type of suffering comes our way, the image of the crucifix can give us spiritual strength and inspiration.
