### DO YOU KNOW?

An Ambry is the box in which the holy oils are kept in Catholic Churches. It is either affixed to the wall or inserted in the wall of the sanctuary. (Etym. Latin Armarium, a chest or safe.) An ambo is a stand from which the priest or another minister reads or speaks to the congregation. It also sometimes is called a pulpit or lecturn. (Etym. Greek ambo, an elevation.)
