QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Morally, we may be living an exemplary life, yet our self-justification and arrogance leaves no room for the grace of God to take hold. God cannot give grace if we are not ready to receive it. If we are proud and complacent, there is not much room for God. However, when we are truly humble we find grace, mercy and peace. There must be space in our lives for grace to enter and work its miracle. We must keep our focus on our relationship with God, recognizing that we are constantly in need of His mercy and forgiveness.

The image of Divine Mercy: Jesus appeared to Saint Faustina Kowalska with rays of red and pale light streaming from the area around His heart. His right hand was raised in blessing, recalling the scene of Easter Sunday night (see Jn 20: 19-23). He asked Saint Faustina to have this vision painted signed with the words, Jesus, I trust in You! He told her that He is offering this as a vessel with which people need to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. The rays represent the blood and water that flowed from His pierced side. He taught Faustina this prayer "O Blood and Water, gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You."
