QUESTION OF THE WEEK

In Old Testament times, mountains were places of prayer and places where God communicated with humans. God revealed Jesus as both God's Son and as the fulfillment of the law and prophets, which were represented by Moses and Elijah. It is through Jesus that we come to understand God's love and plan for the world. Jesus's life, ministry, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension tell us all that God wants to communicate to us. Jesus shared this with Peter, James, and John, so they could share it with others after his death. When we share what we know about Jesus with others, we help others know and experience God's love. Adults: In what ways has the Lord revealed himself to you? Children: What can you say or do to show others the glory of the Lord this week?

DO YOU KNOW?

The pectoral cross (crux pectoralis) is worn by the Holy Father, Cardinals, Bishops, and Abbots. The word pectoral derives from the Latin pectus, meaning "breast." This cross is attached to a chain (or cord) and is worn on the chest, near the heart.
