DO YOU KNOW?

Transubstantiation is the term the Catholic Church uses in relation to the Consecration of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus.

Transubstantiation means the substance part of the bread and wine elements changes; but the accidental parts – sight, taste, smell, touch – do not. Catholics believe that since Jesus said it and He is God, he can do it. This is the source and summit of our faith, that Jesus is truly present, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, in the Eucharist. Jesus tells us in John Chapter 6 (The Bread of Life Discourse) that "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you."
