#### QUESTION OF THE WEEK

If we let fear into our hearts it will surely paralyze us. However, why fear if we have faith and belief in Jesus? The apostles did not let fear defeat them for they knew that even if there was no physical manifestation of His presence there was always His spiritual and sacramental presence before them. Jesus calls us all as well, we who are inadequate for He will make us adequate. We who are half empty for He will fill us until we overflow. And we who are fearful for He will make us courageous. He wants from us to learn to trust Him for he will equip us with anything that we need.

Adult: What fears in your life do you need to turn over to God?

Child: Do you remember to pray to God when you are afraid?

#### DO YOU KNOW?

The ultimate decision in appointing bishops rests with the pope, and he is free to select anyone he chooses. But how does he know whom to select? The process for selecting candidates for the episcopacy normally begins at the diocesan level and works its way through a sries of consultations until it reaches Rome. It is a process bound by strict confidentiality and involves a number of important players – the most influential being the apostolic nuncio, the Congregation for Bishops, and the pope. It can be a time consuming process, often taking eight months or more to complete. While there are distinctions between the first appointment of a priest as a bishop and a bishop's later transfer to another diocese or his promotion to archbishop, the basic outlines of the process remain the same.
