QUESTION OF THE WEEK

We don't need to go to the four corners of the earth to be missionaries. We are called to the same mission as the apostles, to spread the Good News wherever we are – at home, at school, at work, at Church, wherever life takes us. Our actions speak about what we believe and how we live Christian lives as well as our words.

DO YOU KNOW?

Apparitions are not an article of faith. Catholics aren't obliged to believe in any apparition, even those deemed "worthy of belief" by the Church. The Church carefully studies claims of apparitions to protect the faithful from false claims. Every study is done under the direction of the local bishop. No apparition may contradict Church teaching or the Gospel. An apparition may be categorized in three ways: "not worthy of belief" (lacks characteristics of something originating from God); "nothing contrary to the faith" (may or may not be of divine origin); "worthy of belief" (shows traits of an occurrence arranged by God). The Church permits pilgrimages, prayers and liturgies to approved apparition sites. Though belief in apparitions is not mandatory, the Church teachings remind Catholics that Mary is indeed the "Mother of the Church" and perhaps it is safe to assume that this Mother will always be nearby, ready to come when and where the world needs her most.
