QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Using the image of shepherd and sheep, Jesus made an analogy for us to listen to the voice of God. Sometimes we are distracted by other voices that Jesus called “thieves.”

These thieves rob us of our desire to follow Jesus. True sheep, however, know the voice of the shepherd. The shepherd provides safety and life for the sheep.

Adult: What “thieves” keep you from hearing the Shepherd’s voice?

Child: What keeps you from following Jesus?

DO YOU KNOW?

The title of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament was first given to Mary by St. Peter Julian Eymard in May 1868, while speaking to his novices. A few years later he described what her statue should look like: “The Blessed Virgin holds the Infant in her arms; and He holds a chalice in one hand and a Host in the other.” He exhorted them to invoke Mary: “Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament, pray for us who have recourse to thee!” The feast day of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament, May 13, was not officially designated until 1921 – 3 years after our parish was established!
