QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Jesus' statement recognizes the Sadducee's real issue has nothing to do with the hypothetical case of a woman with seven husbands but focuses on the denial of resurrection. He dismisses the Sadducee's assumption that life in the resurrection will be identical to life on earth. He tells us that God, His Father is the God of Life. The mystery of the incarnation and the death and resurrection of Jesus would be meaningless if humans cannot enjoy in eternity the fruits of Jesus' actions.

DO YOU KNOW?

The Catholic Church responded with immediate assistance to Haiti through Catholic Relief Services. CRS provided assistance in completing assessments across affected regions to determine people's greatest need; distributed hygiene kits, kitchen sets and blankets to 1,250 families; provided 9,500 tarpaulins for emergency shelter and provided cash for people to buy vital relief and supplies.
