QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Through today's parable, Jesus teaches us that God answers prayer in His own way and in His own time. If we expect answers in our way and in our time, we are not really turning our needs over to our all loving and merciful God. We are projecting our will, not His. Being able to leave our requests in His hands requires an act of faith that God knows our needs better than we do.

Adult: Does your prayer life reflect your willingness to accept God's answers even when they conflict with your desires?

Child: How can you pray in such a way that God knows you are willing to accept His answer?
