

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

The implication of today's Gospel is that loving our neighbor means more than being kind to our friends and relatives, or to the person who lives next door. Loving one's neighbor means doing right by any widow or orphan: seeing that the hungry are fed and the homeless sheltered, that the poor have their basic needs met, that the unemployed do not suffer from want, that the young are educated and the old are cared for. Adult: What prejudices might be hindering you from being the neighbor you are called to be? Child: Why is it hard to love some "neighbors"?

DO YOU KNOW?

Known liturgically as the "Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed", All Souls Day is often seen as a continuation and extension of the All Saints Day celebrations conducted the day before. While All Saints Day is dedicated to those who are in Heaven, the Church holds that souls who have died and have not been cleansed of the temporal punishment due them as a result of their sins or who have retained attachment to sin cannot enter the Kingdom of Heaven without first being sanctified through purgatory. These souls can be helped toward the reward of Heaven through prayer and sacrifices of the Church Militant, that is to say, the faithful who are still living in this world. All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation with Masses celebrated at OLBS at 8:30am and 7:00pm. All Souls Day is not a Holy Day of Obligation but Daily Mass is offered at 8:30am.
