## QUESTION OF THE WEEK:

The point of today's Gospel is to help us remember that the most important way we can use our resources is in the service of others. The point Jesus wanted to make with this parable is to let us know that we should be wise in our use of the world's goods, because if they are used selfishly, they will fail us. It is not part of our own worldly goods that we give to the poor; what we are giving them is already theirs because we have appropriated what has been given for the fruition of all. We are the stewards of the gifts God has given us.

Adult: Are you being a good steward of the gifts God has given you by sharing them with others?

Child: Do you find it hard to share what God has given you?

## DO YOU KNOW?

The LAVABO DISH is the small flat saucer-shaped bowl that catches the water used in cleansing the fingers of a celebrant at Mass. The liturgical washing of his hands by a priest at Mass, after the Offertory is known as LAVABO. As he washes his hands the priest says "Lord, wash away my iniquity; cleanse me from my sin". The purpose of this rite is to impress upon the priest and congregation the need for "interior purification".
