

#### **QUESTION OF THE WEEK**

It takes discipline to keep our excitement to ourselves. We tell a close friend and make him or her promise not to tell, but somehow word gets out, and before we know it everyone knows what's going on! In today's Gospel, Jesus asks the leper not to share the news of his healing. This invites us to stop and think. A part of being trustworthy is being able to keep things in confidence when we are asked to do so.

Adult: How trustworthy are you in keeping your promises to be confidential?

Child: Are you able to keep your promises not to tell others what's told to you in confidence?

#### DO YOU KNOW?

Lent starts on Ash Wednesday – to allow a full 40 days of fasting before Easter Sunday, just as Jesus fasted for 40 days in the desert. But if you count the days between Ash Wednesday and Easter you will find there are 46. However, the Church sees each Sunday as a feast day in commemoration of Jesus' resurrection so therefore does not call for fasting on Sundays. Since there are six Sundays in Lent, we have to subtract them from the days of fasting. Forty-six minus six is forty.

SAVE THE DATE! 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY GREEN V. COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD OF NEW KENT COUNTY, VA – MAY 2018 – When the Charles C. Green, et al. v. County School Board of New Kent County, VA, et al. decision was handed down on May 27, 1968, the Supreme Court of the United States established the duty of school boards across the country to eliminate all state-imposed segregation, placing an affirmative duty on school boards to "convert to one school system in which racial discrimination would be eliminated." The Green decision is recognized as the US Supreme Court's most significant public school desegregation case following Brown v. Board of Education.
