

The City of Chicago ended 2016 with 786 murders. The community is struggling with violence and even received a message from Pope Francis to "never lose hope". Cardinal Blasé Cupich, archbishop of Chicago committed the Archdiocese to stepping half of his discretionary funds – to grassroots parish and neighborhood initiatives to reach young people and those affected by violence. "If we don't do this as a church, we might as well pack up," Cupich announced. "This is what we should be doing."
