

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

At the end of each episode of the television series "Blue Bloods," the family gathers around the table for Sunday dinner. No matter the difficulties or discouragements of the week, the ritual of the Sunday meal is honored. LENTEN REGULATIONS ON FAST AND ABSTINENCE: <u>Abstinence</u> from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older. <u>Fasting</u> is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Only one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
