

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Instead, he gave us the gifts of peace, forgiveness, and reconciliation so that we could reduce conflict. One of the measures of Christian life is not the absence of conflict, but the manner in which conflict is resolved. Filled with the gift of the Holy Spirit, we ask Jesus to help us to bring peace and forgiveness to situations of conflict we face.

DO YOU KNOW?

Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska of the Blessed Sacrament was born as Helena Kowalska, in Glogowiec, Leczyca County, north-west of Lodz in Poland on August 25, 1905. She was the third of 10 children to a poor and religious family. On February 22, 1931, Faustina was visited by Jesus, who presented himself as the "King of Divine Mercy" wearing a white garment with red and pale rays (representing blood and water) coming from his heart. She was asked to become the apostle and secretary of God's mercy, a model of how to be merciful to others, and an instrument for reemphasizing God's plan of mercy for the world.

Fasting began on Friday evening followed by shopping and filling the Easter food baskets and preparing the spaghetti dinner fundraiser as well as a period of Eucharistic Adoration on Saturday.
