DO YOU KNOW

Two and a half million Haitians live in extreme poverty. Haiti is the poorest country in the northern hemisphere and the 3rd poorest country in the world. Two out of three Haitians live on less than US\$2 per day. Ten percent of the richest Haitians possess 70 percent of the country's total income. One hundred thousand children under 5 years of age suffer from acute malnutrition, while one in three children is stunted, or irreversibly short for their age and one-third of Haitian women and children are anemic. Less than 50 percent of households have access to safe water and only 25 percent benefit from adequate sanitation.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

How many times have you said "prove it to me"? This is basically what the crowds are saying to Jesus today – "Prove it to us. Give us a sign that we might believe in you." Every day God gives us signs that he loves us, cares for us, forgives us, and is with us. We see and hear these signs in creation, in the generous actions of a friend, in the kind words of a stranger, and in the community of believers that is the Church. Take time to reflect on the signs of God's love that you have seen or heard in recent days. Think about how you can be that sign in the week to come to others around you.

Adult: When has my faith helped me believe without seeing? Child: Who helps me believe in things I cannot see?
