The Catholic Church observes the birthday of only two saints: Saint John the Baptist (June 24), and Mary, Mother of Jesus (September 8). In the case of all other saints, especially martyrs, they are venerated on the day of their death, which is called their "dies natalis,", meaning "the day of their birth into heaven".
