#### DO YOU KNOW

In 1831 Catherine MaCauley founded the Sisters of Mercy, a Religious Congregation largely involved in the care of the poor, the sick and educationally disadvantaged. Their name was derived because they were based on the Works of Mercy. In the early days her work was mostly among the people of Dublin, but in time the Congregation spread and became one of the largest Congregations of women, not alone in Ireland, but in the world. The Sisters of Mercy first came to America at the invitation of the Bishop of Pittsburgh in 1843.
