#### DO YOU KNOW

The Roman Catholic Church celebrates November 2 as All Souls Day. It is a solemn celebration commemorating all of those who have died and are now in Purgatory, being cleansed of their venial sins and the temporal punishments for the mortal sins that they had confessed, and being made pure before entering into the presence of God in Heaven. It is also our belief that our prayers can help with their release from Purgatory. PRAYING FOR THE DEAD is a Christian obligation. In the modern world, when many have come to doubt the Church's teaching on Purgatory, the need for such prayers has only increased. The Church devotes the month of November to pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory.

### QUESTION OF THE WEEK

When asked which of the commandments is the greatest, Jesus proclaims that there are two: to love God above things and our neighbors as ourselves. In His view, these are quite inseparable; one cannot be kept without the other. We cannot say we love God and then refuse to love our neighbor. Jesus makes two other refinements. He extends the meaning of "neighbor" to include every single person and not just the people of one's own race, religion or family. We would do well to listen and follow both of these commandments. While they are certainly not easy, following both of these commandments can lead to a freedom on this earth and an eternity in heaven with our Father.

Child: How can you show love to people you don't like?

NEED HELP WITH HEATING OR COOLING? See if you might be eligible at <a href="https://commonhelp.virginia.gov/access/">https://commonhelp.virginia.gov/access/</a>. Applications for help with your heating and cooling bills or equipment needs are accepted online, by calling the Enterprise Customer Service Center at 855-635-4370, and at your local department of social services. Fuel assistance helps with home heating costs; but can also be used for furnace re-starts, late charges, delivery charges, installation charges, and connection fees. Crisis assistance is intended to meet a household's emergency heating need, when no other resource is available.
