DO YOU KNOW

Advent is a time of simultaneously looking back and looking forward. We look back in remembrance of the birth of Christ our Savior more than 2000 years ago and we look forward to his coming again in glory. The Advent season lasts for four Sundays. It begins on the fourth Sunday before Christmas, or the nearest Sunday to November 30. Advent ends on Christmas Eve and thus is not considered part of the Christmas season. The Advent celebration is both a commemoration of Christ's first coming and an anticipation of His second coming. As Israel longed for their Messiah to come, so Christians long for their Savior to come again.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Today's Gospel reminds us that it is important to be ready for the Second Coming of Christ, but it is also important to be prepared for his arrival into every moment of every day. He may come to us through a conversation, in the form of a beggar on the streets, through the words or actions of our children, or through the kindness of a stranger. Are our hearts open to receiving him? Advent affords us the opportunity to prepare our hearts and lives for Christ's coming today, at Christmas, and at the end of all time. This Advent, open your eyes, your ears, and your heart to the coming of Christ in ordinary and extraordinary ways. Adults: What am I doing to prepare for Christ's coming, both at

Christmas and at end times?

Child: How should I prepare for the birthday of Jesus?

Because the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation falls on Saturday, December 8th, and we have no morning Mass on Saturday, a Vigil Mass will be held on Friday, December 7th at 7 p.m., which will fulfill your obligation for the Holy Day. You will still be required to fulfill your Sunday obligation on either Saturday at 5:30 or Sunday at 9 am.

We are also including in this bulletin the Christmas Flowers flyer. Please have your form returned to the office by Tuesday, December 18th. If you have already returned the Christmas Flowers envelope along with your donation, you do not have to repeat the process.
