If you do not wish to be captured by live streaming, please refrain from attending the 9am Sunday Mass.

Per the Virginia Department of Health:

1. Unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated individuals should wear masks in public indoor settings.
2. Fully vaccinated individuals do not need to wear a mask; however, masks should be worn in indoor settings in areas of substantial and high transmission.
3. Any person not wearing a mask shall not be required to produce documentation that they are vaccinated or that they have an underlying medical condition.

When your time comes, St. Joseph will help you experience a happy and holy death.

## Saint of the Week

*February 23rd - St. Polycarp, Bishop & Martyr*

St. Polycarp was a disciple of St. John the apostle. While still quite young, he became the bishop of Smyrna and was one of the most respected leaders in the first half of the second century. St. Ignatius of Antioch and St. Irenaeus spoke highly of him. Polycarp was a Christian leader in a pagan world. He spoke clearly and simply, fearless in love and defense of Christ, even though persecutions raged around him. He sought only to hand on the message he had been given by John. Polycarp was seized for being a Christian. Persecution and death would not tear him away from Jesus. He was sentenced to death by fire. An eyewitness account claims that the flames didn't harm him. He was finally killed by the sword, and his body was burned. The community of believers celebrated the anniversary of Polycarp's death with great joy, for in him they had seen an outstanding example of love and patience.

Lent begins Ash Wednesday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>. Masses on that day will be 8:30am and 7:00pm. While it is not a Holy Day of Obligation, many see Ash Wednesday as the beginning of their personal Lenten journey to strengthen their relationship with Jesus. Please remember that this day is a Day of Fast and Abstinence, as is Good Friday. All Fridays during Lent are Days of Abstinence.

We will also have the Holy Rosary and Stations of the Cross every Friday of Lent. The Holy Rosary will be led by Father Oscar and begin at 6:30pm. The Stations of the Cross will begin at 7:00pm and will be led by members of the following committees:

### Parish Synod Questionnaire

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has called for a Synod to take place over the next two years. A Synod is a process of gathering information from individual parishes, then from all the diocese around the world, ending with a meeting of Cardinals in Rome with the Pope to study all responses.

It is a process of "journeying together." We plan to use this information to guide the future of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church as well as contribute to the information gathered in the Richmond Diocese.

To gather information from our Parish, the Parish Council has put together a set of questions and we are asking everyone to take several weeks to pray about these questions and answer them.
