

Here are a few suggestions:

-Play audio or DVD's that focus on Mercy;

The Season of Lent

The importance of the 40 days in Lent

Following the legalization of Christianity in the Roman Empire during the fourth century, Lent had developed into its current length of *forty days*, forty-six if you count Sundays that are not actually included in Lent. Fasting during Lent is actually practiced for six days of the week over the six weeks of Lent, excluding Sundays.

Forty days in itself holds significance for Christians due to several biblical events:

- Moses receiving the Ten Commandments on top of Mount Sinai, "Moses was there with the Lord forty days and forty nights without eating bread or drinking water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant—the Ten Commandments" (Exodus 34:28)
- Elijah's walk to Mount Sinai, "So he got up and ate and drank. Strengthened by that food, he traveled forty days and forty nights until he reached Horeb, the mountain of God" (1 Kings 19:8)
- Most importantly when Jesus was tested in the wilderness, "Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, where for forty days he was tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and at the end of them he was hungry" (Luke 4:1-13).

Please remember that <u>Good Friday is a Day of Fast and</u> <u>Abstinence</u> and that <u>ALL Fridays during Lent are Days of</u> <u>Abstinence.</u>
