

Year of Grace and Divine Mercy

(The Diary of St. Faustina)

Meditation:

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy. Then He said to me, My daughter, fear nothing. I am always with you, even if it seems to you that I am not. Your humility draws Me down from my lofty throne, and I unite Myself closely with you (Diary, 1109)

My Prayer Response: Lord Jesus, draw all souls, especially poor sinners, to turn to Your mercy on the Feast of Mercy and receive complete pardon! Help us to fear nothing and place our trust in You.

Promises for Divine Mercy Sunday

Happy Easter! We are now at the Octave of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday! Saturday vigil mass and Sunday mass, we celebrate this great feast that holds to fulfilled message of Easter. Jesus said to Faustina, "On that day ALL the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet." Did you notice the word "ALL" in the promise Jesus gave to Faustina notates here? Yes, Jesus promises that "ALL the divine floodgates" are open. What does that mean?

That means there are many ways MERCY will flow upon souls and the world on the Feast of Mercy. Some may receive more, and some may receive less, but Jesus made it clear that He wants to pour His mercy upon the whole world, especially great sinners. Now is our chance to go for it!

What do I need to do?

The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

A - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

B - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

C - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received by our trust. The more we open the door of our hearts and lives to Him with trust, the more we can receive.

"People forget that we are forgiven of our sins in the confessional, but most likely, the punishment remains. The Lord promises that on the Feast of Divine Mercy, if you go to confession asking for forgiviness and receive Holy Communion, you will be forgiven of your sins and all punishment for those sins is wiped away. "Never will your soul be cleaner than it is on that day, other than your original baptism."

Jesus, I trust in you!
