Our local Father Jakubowski Council #8116 is honored to be able to display the Silver Rose. There are three "Silver Rose's" traveling the country.

In 1960, young members of the Knights of Columbus in Monterrey, Mexico wanted to give back as a way to commemorate the miracle that took place 500 years ago when live roses in the middle of winter given to Juan Diego from Our Lady of Guadalupe.

These Mexican Knights began a new tradition of delivering a silver rose to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

The tradition continued in 2001 when a Silver Rose was blessed by Bishop Alfonso Espino Silva and sent to the Knights of Columbus main office in New Haven, Connecticut. And the tradition continues – not only to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe, but to reaffirm the Order's dedication to the sanctity of human life.

THE ONLY SON OF GOD

Peter could recognize the transcendent character of the Messiah's divine sonship because Jesus had clearly allowed it to be so understood. To his accusers' question before the Sanhedrin, "Are you the Son of God, then?" Jesus answered, "You say that I am." *[Lk 22:70; cf. Mt 26:64; Mk 14:61-62]* Well before this, Jesus referred to himself as "the Son" who knows the Father, as distinct from the "servants" God had earlier sent to his people; he is superior even to the angels. *[Cf. Mt 11:27; 21:34-38; 24:36]* He distinguished his sonship from that of his disciples by never saying "our Father", except to command them: "You, then, pray like this: 'Our Father'", and he emphasized this distinction, saying "my Father and your Father". *[Mt 5:48; 6:8-9; 7:21; Lk 11:13; Jn 20:17]* [2786] (CCC 443)

Jubilee Year of Hope 2025-

Pope Leo XIII proclaimed the Jubilee in 1900 with the prospect of overcoming widespread moral degradation; just think of the condition of workers in that time and it is clear why this was the theme.

The 1925 Jubilee emphasized the theme of fraternity: the useless slaughter was behind and European totalitarianisms were on the horizon.

The Jubilee of 1950 had the tone of reconstruction, faced with a Europe (and a world) full of physical and moral rubble after World War II.

In 1975, Paul VI chose the theme of reconciliation and communion in a tense post-conciliar time—but also in a climate of the Cold War.

John Paul II proclaimed the year 2000 as the great Jubilee of the Incarnation, a gateway to the third millennium. Today is the time for hope.

The Creator's Eternal Dream

Pope Francis, in his Apostolic Exhortation "The Joy of Love," writes, "The Psalmist says: "You knit me together in my mother's womb" (Ps 139:13). Every child growing within the mother's womb is part of the eternal loving plan of God the Father: "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you" (Jer 1:5). Each child has a place in God's heart from all eternity; once he or she is conceived, the Creator's eternal dream comes true. Let us pause to think of the great value of that embryo from the moment of conception. We need to see it with the eyes of God, who always looks beyond mere appearances." (AL, 168)
