

#### THE ONLY SON OF GOD

The Gospels report that at two solemn moments, the Baptism and the Transfiguration of Christ, the voice of the Father designates Jesus his "beloved Son". [Cf. Mt 3:17; cf. 17:5] Jesus calls himself the "only Son of God", and by this title affirms his eternal pre-existence. [Jn 3:16; cf. 10:36] He asks for faith in "the name of the only Son of God". [Jn 3:18] In the centurion's exclamation before the crucified Christ, "Truly this man was the Son of God", [Mk 15:39] that Christian confession is already heard. Only in the Paschal mystery can the believer give the title "Son of God" its full meaning. [536, 544]



#### Jubilee Year of Hope 2025-

Pope Leo XIV: The soil where the seed in the parable lands "is our heart, but it is also the world, the community, the church," he said. "The word of God, in fact, makes fruitful and provokes every reality."

What happens to the seed depends on the quality of the earth it lands on, he said. "But first and foremost, in this parable Jesus tells us that God throws the seed of his word on all kinds of soil, that is, in any situation of ours," the pope said. "At times we are more superficial and distracted; at times we let ourselves get carried away by enthusiasm; sometimes we are burdened by life's worries, but there are also times when we are willing and welcoming." "God is confident and hopes that sooner or later the seed will blossom," Pope Leo said.

"This is how he loves us: he does not wait for us to become the best soil, but he always generously gives us his word." When people see how God loves and trusts them, the pope said, it should encourage them to be "better soil."


