

I entered the Our Lady of Peöafrancia Seminary in high school at the young age of 12 in 1990, month of June. I entered the college department of the same seminary in 1994. Then, I entered the Holy Rosary Major Seminary for my Theological Studies in Naga City, Philippines, in 1998, until I graduated in 2002. Most Rev. Arturo Bastes, Bishop Emeritus of the Diocese of Sorsogon, ordained me as deacon on June 25, 2003 and ordained me, a year later, as priest on June 19, 2004.

I arrived in the United States for the first time, on July 6, 2024 Saturday midnight and stayed at St. Mary Star of the Sea Parish in Fort Monroe until the bishop of Richmond, Most Rev. Barry Knestout, assigned me as a parochial vicar of St. Bede Parish, Williamsburg, Virginia on July 13, 2024.

Now, I am happy to begin my new parish assignment at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament, here at West Point, from the first of July, 2025, until I am allowed to serve and to stay by our beloved bishop, Bishop Knestout.

[St. Faustina was tempted repeatedly by Satan against her vocation of proclaiming God's mercy and praying for mercy for souls, especially sinners (see *Diary*, 1496-1499):]

At that moment, I saw Jesus, who said, I am pleased with what you are doing. And you can continue to be at peace if you always do the best you can in respect to this work of mercy. Be absolutely as frank as possible with your confessor.

Satan gained nothing by tempting you, because you did not enter into conversation with him. Continue to act in this way. You gave Me great glory today by fighting so faithfully (*Diary*, 1499).

My Prayer Response:

Lord, may I be faithful to my vocation at times of temptation. May I not enter into temptation by conversation with the Evil One. By the grace of Your presence, help me to withstand temptations.

Location: Brittingham-Midtown Community Center, 570 McLawhorne Drive Newport News, VA 23601 The patient parking lot will open no later than 11:59 p.m. (midnight local time) on Friday night, August 1, and remain open. As patients arrive at the parking lot, they will be provided with additional information regarding clinic opening processes and next steps. Clinic doors typically open at 6 a.m.

Patients should be prepared with their own food, water, medicines, and clothing when arriving early. Bathrooms will be provided.

Free dental, vision, and medical services are provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Due to time constraints, be prepared to choose between DENTAL and VISION services. Medical services are offered to every patient attending the clinic.


All services are free and open to the public. No ID required.
